It's true. The DNR is at it again. This time, the department is creating new rules that could make your pier illegal. Can you believe it? These new regulations will apply to both new and existing piers, and if your pier does not meet the DNR's new standards, you must pay \$50 or \$300 and obtain a permit to keep your pier. Even if you've owned it for several decades.

Talk about pier pressure.

The Wisconsin Homeowners Alliance is working to stop these rules and ensure that existing piers can remain in place without a permit, and that the right of waterfront property owners to place a pier is protected.

If you have any concerns about the new pier rules and regulations, contact Governor Doyle at (608) 266-1212 and your legislators at (800) 362-9472. Ask them to tell the DNR to leave your pier alone, and go jump in the lake.
