¹ Note – If a property is subject to zoning ordinances or comprehensive plans of more than one local government (e.g., Town and County, or Town and Village (extraterritorial zoning)) and the property owner wants to receive notice of changes to all zoning ordinances or comprehensive plans that could affect the use of his/her property, the property owner must send this form to each of the local governments that have the authority to create ordinances or plans that could affect the use of his/her property.
